

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2009/10

It gives me great pleasure to present this, the Annual Report of Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club for 200/10.

Again, the last year has been a very successful one for the club and its members, both on and off the track. The club again had success on the track, winning the Athletics South Interclub Premiership for Men, Women and Combined again. One of the highlights of the track season was winning the Blake Shield for the Combined Points in the Tasmanian Club Championships in Penguin. This was the first time we have won this trophy, which is named in honour of an Eastern Suburbs Life Member. This success also means that in the last three years, Eastern Suburbs have won every possible Club trophy at Athletics South and Athletics Tasmania level, and currently hold all except 1.

Winter competition levels have stagnated a bit this year in numbers, but certainly not in quality. Regular numbers at all levels, and our strengths this year have been in the Under 16 girls, and the Over 40 men. We still struggle to challenge Northern Suburbs because of their numbers, but continue to maintain the social side of the winter, and closely battle with Sandy bay and Masters each week in both male and female competitions. One absolute highlight of the year was the performance of our athletes in the Tasmanian team in Brisbane recently, topped off by Biniyam Hagos winning two gold medals, including the Australian U/14 Cross Country Championship. It gave me particular pleasure to be team manager and be there for this fantastic performance (even if it meant losing my voice for 3 days). This event also saw Kiara Chambers' first appointment as a Tasmanian Team Manager, and she joins Chris Edwards as younger members of the club who have taken this step up.

Summer performances continue to be at a high standard, both with quality and quantity, and the change of format of Australian Underage Championships in the upcoming season, should see a number of athletes achieve Tasmanian representation again.

Financially, even I was amazed when I received the Treasurer's report to see how strong a financial position the club currently sits in, and this hopefully be maintained through the regular fund raising opportunities which we currently have, as well a new one which will be outlined tonight.

Our coaching numbers continue to grow, with Peter Turnock, Craig Griggs, Jy Webb, and Evan Peacock, along with support from Peter McDonald, Wayne Mason, Kevin Alomes and Andrew Edwards, along with many more, attract athletes of all ages to our club, due to them being accepted and developed, regardless of age and ability.

I would also like to acknowledge our financial supporters;

As we move into another athletic year, there will hopefully be consolidation of the changes which were made last year within Athletics South. I have also taken on the role of Track & Field Director for Athletics South, so hopefully this area will continue to grow, along with the implementation of a state-wide interclub in early 2011.

Thank you to all the committee and supporters of the club, you are far too many to mention (and I don't want to miss any out), and feel free to take the step up and nominate yourself for the committee or any other role you may have interest in throughout the year.

Treasurer's Report 2009-2010

For the year ending June 30th 2010, the Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club recorded a healthy net surplus of \$9345.56. This is in excess of \$7k more than the profit we achieved in 2008-09.

Significantly this year, the decision was made to close the Perpetual Trustees account (which at the time contained \$7190.59) and open two term deposit accounts with MyState Financial. The term deposit accounts were created with \$5000 each. The first term was for 7 months (due for maturity on 19 August 2010), the second for 24 months (due for maturity on 19 January 2012). Due to the demutualisation of MyState Financial the club received a windfall of \$967.50 through the sale of its MyState Financial shareholding.

The success of our fundraising activities is always dependent on the willingness and enthusiasm of athletes and parents to volunteer their time. This year's major fundraising activities include the City to Casino and Point to Pinnacle fun runs and Parliament House car parking.

Income from fund raising activities is received when club members, friends and athlete's parents undertake volunteer work in order to raise funds for the Club. Activities undertaken during 2008-09 included The Round the River Run was again financially successful for the Club, with sponsorship and entry fees exceeding costs by \$4924 (2009 \$3310.50, 2008, \$2492.00, and 2007, \$2505.00). In this regard, the financial contributions made by Signature For Property, Pace Financial Services and K&D Mitre 10 greatly assisted the Club in conducting this activity.

Due to the club's strong financial position we have been able to provide travel subsidies to our athletes representing the club interstate to the value of \$2055. We have also purchased \$2434.03 of new equipment to assist our athletes.

Danni also won the Doreen Frawley Award for the third time. This shows what great sportsmanship she has and is definitely a well deserved participant for this award. We also had a number of athlete's receiving awards at the Athletics South AGM and Athletics Tasmania awards evening, which was great to finally award those athletes on their outstanding performances throughout the season.

Club Champs was one of the highlights to the season. Despite the long journey, and the girls unable to gain a higher placing than the previous year, we all had a great time and hopefully next year we can improve on this result and finish in the top three. This year was the first time that Eastern Suburbs had won the Combined Blake Trophy at the Club Championships and hopefully this won't be the last.

The Cross Country Season is currently under way with the Eastern Suburbs Women currently sitting in third place. There have been a number of talented athletes developing in this area, as can be seen by their great performances at the Australian Cross Country Championships held previously. I'm sure their progress will be keenly watched in years to come.

I would just like to thank all those that helped out during the season, in particular the officials, coaches, Eastern Suburbs committee, athletes, parents and spectators. Without your help and dedication towards the sport, interclub wouldn't be made possible each week and to this we owe a big thank you. I look forward to the next up and coming season.

The 2009/10 athletics season for the Eastern Suburbs Men started with a bang with convincing wins at track and field interclubs meets. The end result was that the men retained the Athletics South Interclub trophy by winning all but one of the interclub rounds.

The track and field season was highlighted with a number of great team efforts with the Eastern Suburbs men retaining both the "Hobart Harriers Cup" at the State Championships and the Open Men's State Club Championship. The men then combined with the Eastern Suburbs women to win, for the first time, the Blake Trophy also at State Club Championship and the inaugural Relay Championships Trophy.

The end of the track and field season saw many of the men nominated and winning awards at both the Athletics South and Athletics Tasmania Awards night. This was some well deserved recognition for many outstanding and consistent performances over the course of the season.

The 2010 cross country season is currently underway with Eastern Suburbs sitting in second place, on par with our great performance last year. The winter season has also seen some great performances with athletes making it into the top 10 in the Road Running, Cross Country and Handicap Championships, as well as in the Athlete of the Year Standings. A number of athletes were rewarded for their efforts by being chosen to represent the state in the National cross-country championships, the highlight of which was the performance of Biniyam Hagos in winning the under 14, 3 kilometre race.

The Autumn/Winter Throws Competition has also proven to be a very popular with a large number of athletes competing and enjoying their sport with many personal and season best performances.

On behalf of the athletes I'd like to thank everyone that is involved in organising and officiating at the numerous competitions throughout the year, those that come along to support the athletes, club coaches for their services to the athletes and the Eastern Suburbs board and committee for all their hard work, your efforts are very much appreciated by all.

Having several club coaches enables valuable mentoring of new coaches and more one-on-one time to be spent with each athlete. The Club policy of fostering the accreditation of new coaches will continue so that the Club will provide a growing list of successful accredited coaches for all areas of athletics. A specialist Jump coach and Hurdles coach is urgently required. Female coaches are encouraged to apply.

The Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club and parents can be very proud of the effort of all our athletes, from Junior through to Master athletes, whether training with the Club squads or with the affiliated individual coaches. All athletes have worked hard at improving their talents and athletes and Club have been enjoying their deserved successes. Athletes have represented Australia or Tasmania at International or National competitions and other athletes are members of National or TIS Athletic Development squads.

The club will continue to support and encourage the accreditation of new coaches and the further education of existing coaches. Persons interested in a coaching role are encouraged to step forward. Coaches (Club and affiliated), you all deserve the Club's, your athletes, and parents congratulations for the coaching of your athletes with improvements throughout a very successful athletic year. Please assist the club by volunteering for committee duties or other work as requested.
