

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2010/11

It gives me great pleasure to present this, the Annual Report of Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club for 2010/11.

The last year for the club was again a very successful one, both for the club as a whole, as well as individuals within the club. We have seen two more join the list of Australian Representatives, with Danni McConnell and Bec Direen both traveling overseas this year.

Track & Field again saw the club retain the three Athletics South Interclub Premierships, as well as the Relay Championship and the Hobart Harrier Cup. There will be changes to some trophies in the next year, with Athletics South no longer holding the Relay Championship, and Athletics Tasmania no longer holding the Club Championship as a stand alone event. As the Club Championships is the Blake Trophy, we have put in a submission to ensure this trophy continues in some format, possibly linked to Tasmanian Championships weekend.

Out Of Stadium numbers have stagnated slightly, and we continue to struggle in AS Out of stadium interclub due to a lack of competitors in the O/40 and O/50 age groups. Having said that, we have both quality and quantity in the younger age groups, with a large group again having attended the Australian Cross Country in Canberra last weekend.

Off the track one of the highlights this year was receiving a substantial cheque from Telstra as a result of a promotion involving the Athletics Tasmania clubs and the Telstra stores. This money will be put towards development, including the trailer which has now been purchased. There are a number of other development ideas under way, including a proposal for reduced entry to Clarence Pool for club members, and an incentive scheme for existing members to recruit new members.

New coaches remains one of our areas of concern, and while club coaches Peter Turnock and Jy Webb are assisted by numerous others, including Wayne Mason, Kevin Alomes, Peter McDonald, Robbie Newson, Evan Peacock, Scott Goldsmith and Andrew Edwards, we have a shortage of new coaches, in particular in the jumps area. If we are to continue attracting new members, we need to ensure that we can facilitate them with coaching opportunities.

We continue to be in a strong financial position, mainly due to the continuing success of the Round The River, however I received advice this week that, due to the building at Parliament House, it appears that we have lost one fantastic fundraiser over Christmas. I would like to acknowledge the support of Sullivan's Cove Rotary Club in allowing us this opportunity over an extended period.

I would also like to acknowledge the ongoing support of sponsors Signature For Property (Phil Turner), Pace Financial Services (Mike Pace), Clarence Council (Wendy Moles) and Running Edge (Kim Gillard), as well as Genesis Fitness (Terry Moore) and Telstra T Life Stores (Steve Lance).

As we move onto another athletics year, there will be minimal changes to the Athletics South interclub, with Scott Miller taking over my role of Track & Field Director. There will also be minor changes in the calendar, particularly in relation to state level events, which will continue to benefit all athletes. Hopefully we will also see the traditional growth of Olympic years, and maybe even an Eastern Suburbs athlete or two competing in London.

From a personal point of view, I have reduced my AS roles, to return to more club based activities, as I hope to find the enjoyment of athletics again. I would like to thank David Conley, Simone Grimmond and Steph Webb who are not continuing in roles on the committee, and thank them for all they have done over their time. I would also like to welcome those who have already put their hand up to take up committee roles, and hopefully we will have a full committee again this year.

Treasurer's Report 2010-2011

For the year ending June 30th 2011, the Eastern Suburbs Athletics club recorded a healthy net surplus of \$10,031.19. This is slightly more than the profit we achieved in 2009-10, but does not take into account a current liability of \$3015 for the newly purchased trailer.

The Eastern Suburbs working account held 20488.08 as of June 30, 2010. The two term deposit accounts created with MyState Financial in 2009-10 were continued this year. The first account was reinvested for a further 7 months on 19 August, and then again on 19 March for 6 months (due to a better rate - 6.1%). This account now holds \$5362.08. The second account is still on a 24 month term (due for maturity on 19 January 2012 at 6.4%) and thus currently holds \$5000.

The success of our fundraising activities is always dependent on the willingness and enthusiasm of athletes, parents and others who volunteer their time. This year's major fundraising activities include the City to Casino and Point to Pinnacle fun runs and the Rotary Parliament House car parking. These activities raised over \$3500 for the club. A significant source of income this year was provided by Telstra through a donation of \$7200. Thanks should be noted to Steve Lance for his involvement in the Telstra donation.

The Round the River fun run was again a successful event for the club. Sponsorship and entries for our marquee event provided almost \$5000 in income for the club, resulting in a profit of close to \$3000. The support provided by Signature First National and Pace Financial Services should be acknowledged at this point.

Due to the club's strong financial position we have been able to provide travel subsidies to over 20 athletes representing the club interstate and internationally. The value of travel subsidies this year was \$3620. The club also made the decision to purchase a trailer for transporting gear to and from cross country races and other club events. The cost of the trailer is approximately \$3000 (including signage), however this expense had not been paid at the close of the financial year.

CLUB CAPTAIN'S REPORT 2010-2011

The 2010-2011 Athletics Season proved to be yet another exciting and successful year for the Eastern Suburbs Athletes. The season started with both old and new faces, of all ages and abilities, which is pleasing to see for the continued growth of the club.

The track and field season was highlighted with a number of great efforts. The Eastern Suburbs men dominated the points scoring winning every round of interclub and retained the Men's Summer Premiership. This season was the first time in a number of years that the women had been challenged for the Women's Summer Premiership. It came down to a close battle with the Northern Suburbs women, however, the Eastern Suburbs women were able to retain the Women's Summer Premiership and combined with the men to win the Combined Premiership and Relay Championship. This shows that every athlete's contribution at interclub each week is important and appreciated.

Once again the Eastern Suburbs men were able to retain the "Hobart Harriers Cup" for most points scored at the State Championships. Eastern Suburbs men performed well in all disciplines, in particular the field events and in the case of the Discus, Javelin and Hammer won all three medals. The Eastern Suburbs women only narrowly missed out on winning the Kohl Shield, with the result coming down to the last event of the competition.

This season's Tasmanian Club Championships was poorly represented by nearly all clubs, including Eastern Suburbs. In previous years, Eastern Suburbs men have been able to put together a strong team, however, this year the attitude of some male and female athletes was very poor, with very few athletes willing to make the effort to represent their club. Eastern Suburbs entered a male and female team, with three U/16 athletes selected as part of the men's open team. To the credit of both teams chosen, all athletes performed well beyond what was expected, with the men coming a close second to Sandy Bay and the women finishing second behind Northern Suburbs. Unfortunately this year the club was unable to retain the Combined Blake Trophy.

Eastern Suburbs also entered a U/16 team, comprising of the three athletes chosen as part of the men's open team. These athletes decided to make the most of the competition entering additional events in the U/16 competition and surprisingly came home with the Bronze medal. The Cross Country Season is currently under way with the Eastern Suburbs men and women both sitting in third place. Despite starting the 2011 season well the men have fallen away after being in first place after round 3, this is due to inconsistent numbers competing each week. Last year the women finished in third place and the men finished in second place, which is one of the best efforts by the men's team for a number of seasons.

While Eastern Suburbs has been able to achieve great successes over the past year, a drop in team spirit has been noticed, particularly with the older athletes. Many athletes have opted to focus specifically on the individual aspects of our sport, leaving very few people willing to run relays or participate as part of an Eastern Suburbs team. At times, this has made the role of club captain challenging and we hope that in the next up and coming season, individuals can be more team orientated, what Eastern Suburbs is known for.
