PRESIDENTS REPORT 2005/06

2005/6 has been another successful year, both on and off the track, for Eastern Suburbs. The highlight of the year was the celebration of the 50th anniversary of the formation of Eastern Suburbs. The culmination of this celebration was a function at Bellerive Yacht Club, which featured some great memories and experiences being relayed by athletes and officials from various eras of the 50 year development. Highlights included the amount of people who returned from interstate to attend, and also the amount of athletes and officials from other clubs who supported this event. I also must mention the behind the scenes people who made this such a great night, in particular Bill Halley, Roger Howlett, Barrie Wise, Wayne Mason and Peter and Maureen McDonald. Some of the minutes was very entertaining, with about 5 minutes of discussion about the dinner, but meetings going for 3 hours..... Looking at some of those names, I am sure many would understand.

On the track, we again swept the three Athletics South premierships, which was achieved not only as a result of some of the great individual performances, but also by the amount of people competing in their "non-core" events for a bit of fun, and also to pick up a point here or there. We have some incredible potential coming through, most evidently in the throws area, but also on the track and jumps. There have been rounds in the last two seasons where we have won or lost by one or two points, and at the end of the day, this point could win us a premiership.

Off the track, and in the cooler months, we still struggle to have the numbers competing in the winter, but those who do compete, see the great enjoyment which can be achieved by taking part in the cross country and fun runs. Our numbers are slowly growing, and hopefully will continue to do so. There are some links starting to develop between the club and other sporting clubs which can hopefully flow on to increase our numbers. My dream is to see us win a premiership in the winter, but to do so by having a massive number of participants just out having fun and scoring one point each, and accumulating points that way. Come along and have a try, you might be surprised how much fun the events are, not only to run/walk/waddle in, but also the social culture which surrounds the winter season. Peter Mac can even demonstrate how to cross the finish line in the wrong direction and still figure in results. That wouldn't happen on the track.

Even further off the track, we are always welcoming of new faces on the committee and helping out at events. One of my big concerns is that we still see the same faces at the events from which we get our

revenue, but different faces to those who we support when state teams are named. All I ask is that next time you receive some benefit from the club, just consider how easy it is to spend half an hour, or a morning on a drink station at the Point to Pinnacle, or taking late entries at the City to Casino, or even directing cars at Parliament House over Christmas. One day the "regulars" will all be busy on the same day, and someone else will have to put their hand up. I would much rather receive volunteers..... Give it consideration please.

In closing, I have decided to put my name forward for another year as President, if that is the wish of the club. Having said that, I would like to see some new faces on the committee, to start to develop some future direction for the executive and the committee. Also, I mentioned a couple of highlights earlier. One of the big highlights was to have a letter received at a committee meeting from a parent, asking if she could organize a fund raising venture. This venture was organized, held and plans made for a future one. It was not difficult and the results were great. Give 5 minutes to consider whether you could do this, or even, as mentioned earlier, give a pleasant Sunday morning to one of the other events and functions which have kept this great club running for the past 50 years, and hopefully for another 50.

TREASURER'S REPORT 2005-06

For the year ended 30 June 2006, the Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club recorded a net loss of \$681.94. This is a slightly disappointing result, following last years surplus of \$1 435.18, however some 2005 Trophy Night costs (\$525.52) were included in the 2005-06 result.

For 2005-06, overall income was down by \$2 170.23 or 18.56%. Primarily, this was as a result of registration fees no longer being paid to the Club. Donations, which is a major source of revenue for the Club, also decreased from \$4 996.38 in 2004-05 to \$3 099.00 in 2005-06. This decrease resulted from the departure of Athletics South from the Clean Team at the Taste of Tasmania.

Donations are received when club members, friends and athlete parents undertake volunteer work in order to raise funds for the Club. Activities undertaken during 2005-06 included the City to Casino, Point to Pinnacle and Women in Sport fun runs, Parliament House car parking, the Hobart Triathlon and the Race to the Taste.

The Round the River Run was again financially successful for the Club, with sponsorship and entry fees exceeding costs by \$1 461.50. In this regard, the financial contribution made by Mike Pace of Pace Financial Services greatly assisted the Club in conducting this activity.

With the Club celebrating its 50th anniversary during the year, both income and expenditure included an amount associated with this once off and very successful activity.

In the area of expenditure, the Club considers it important that it is able to provide travel subsidies to members who have gained state selection, and during 2005-06, the total subsidies paid by the Club increased. However, as all members will understand, in order to maintain the current subsidy levels for our athletes, the Club must remain financial. In this regard, when volunteer assistance is sought, I ask that you do consider making some of your time available to assist the Club over the coming year.

Finally, as this has been my first year on the Committee, I would especially like to thank all my fellow Committee members for their assistance, as well as all the athletes and parents who have assisted in any way throughout the past year.

The Club squads together with affiliated squads coached by Wayne Mason and Kevin Alomes have had outstanding results, dominating most junior, and youth events and Eastern Suburbs Athletics Club will be very strong in the future.



This year, Athletics Tasmania has funded further coaching accreditation courses and the Club will select interested and involved members to undergo coach education. Step forward.
