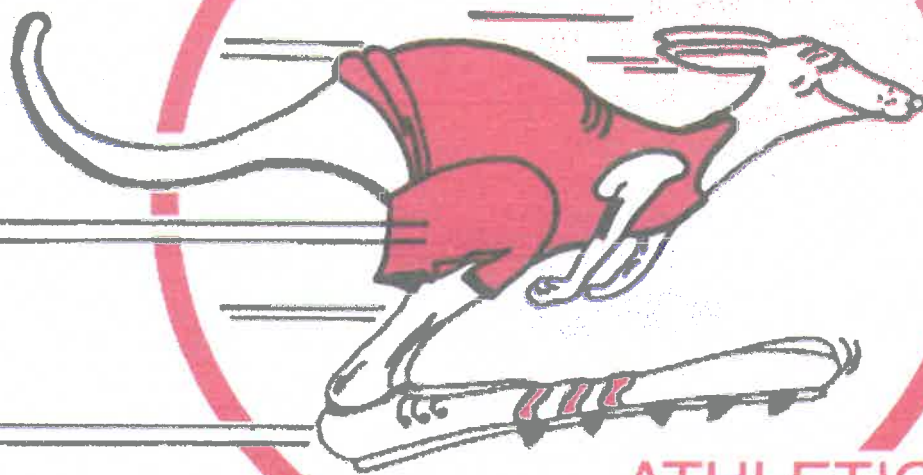

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2006-7

I write this report with mixed emotions at the end of my third year in this position. I will highlight the success that the club has had in the past twelve months, on the local, national and international scene, and on and off the track. In contrast I will express some concerns over the succession which does not appear to be happening with the administrative side of the club, and the negative effect this may have on the club.

Eastern Suburbs ends this year as the reigning Athletics South Men's, Women's and Combined Premiers for the third year in succession. We also regained the Hobart Harriers Cup for the most successful club in Senior Men's Tasmanian Championship events, having loaned the trophy to Sandy Bay for a year. We have also witnessed some fantastic individual performances from Hamish and Huw Peacock, and Rebecca Direen, breaking too many state records to list, as well as Hamish winning numerous Australian medals and a World silver medal. There were also many fantastic performances at lesser level from grass roots athletes at the Domain. One performance which I think summed up why this club is so successful was that of Aaron Humphrey in the Australian Club Championships, stepping up to fill a gap at very short notice, and helping us to be the best performed Tasmanian club in this event.

My concern is more off the track. When I took on this role, I only ever intended to do two years at the most. I am now concluding my third year, and due to a total lack of interest being expressed by anybody else in stepping up to vice-president, let alone president, I am left with the dilemma of going with what my head tells me, and stepping down, and leaving the position vacant, or going with my heart and not leaving the club potentially without an executive in what could be a tumultuous year as Athletics Tasmania attempt to implement a system which, try as I might, I can not as an individual fully support.

When we created a second vice president position, it was intended that one would be an incoming vice, while the other would be the past president, creating a succession triad. Unfortunately this has not occurred, for various reasons, meaning that in my three years, I have (luckily) had Maureen as my vice president for all 3 years, and 3 different people in the other position each year. If (and at the time of writing, it is a massive if), I decide to do a fourth year, I would like to think that both vice president positions will be filled by people who twelve months from now will be prepared to maybe even face each other in election for president. It is not a hard role, for some reason people just don't seem to want the title. You have the rest of the meeting to think about it, as I still have not made a decision.

In closing I would like to acknowledge a few people in particular for their assistance over the last three years. You will notice something in common with all these people, they all got involved with the club because of their children, and none of them still have children competing regularly.

Maureen and Peter MacDonald, Roger and Helen Howlett, Peter Turnock and Wendy Sheppard. These people do so much throughout the year, in particular the Howletts who never miss an out of stadium event, be it an Athletics South event or fun run, in particular Roger's immense assistance with the Round the River Run.

Two others, in the younger category, are Monica Howlett and Rob Cracknell. Monica took over the Clubs Online registrations while I was overseas, and maintained the registrations for that time, despite minor hitches which arose during that time. Rob's work on the Eastern Suburbs website has been fantastic, and hopefully we can get it up there alongside Sandy Bay's website, but he can only update it if you give him something to put on it.

Thank you to all those and others who have not been mentioned due to lack of space, and I hope the club and the sport prosper through the upcoming changes which will occur with the implementation of the statewide interclub competition.

CLUB CAPTAINS REPORT

Eastern Suburb Male Club Captains Report 2006/07

The 2006/07 track season was very successful for the entire Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club. The men started the season well with good individual efforts and scoring valuable points for the club. The men comfortably won the first five weeks of the interclub competition before narrowly coming second behind Sandy Bay. From here the men only dropped two weeks for the rest of the season comfortably winning the men's interclub trophy for the third year running. Eastern Suburbs also took out the combined trophy for the third consecutive year.

Also this year, Eastern Suburbs sent a team to Penguin to compete in the Tasmanian Club Championships where we finished second behind North Launceston. This was a great result because it gave athletes a chance to compete outside their 'pet' events. Robert Cracknell was seen running a 3000m, Matthew Wass competed in the 800m, Huw Peacock did the Long Jump and Hamish Peacock competed in the 100m. This result allowed us to enter a team in the National Club Championships. The National Club Champs saw the return of athletes to their more common events where everyone performed exceptionally well. The final result saw Eastern Suburbs finished 6th, beating home North Launceston as the best placed Tasmanian Club.

The top 10 points scorers this year was again hotly contested with some places not being decided until the last week of competition. Chris McConnell finished a close second behind myself followed by Huw Peacock in third place. Well done to every body that placed in the top ten, and those that were just outside, all gaining valuable points for the club.

The captains award this year was awarded to Aaron Humphrey, Aaron attended most interclub events, when he was at the track he was always will to compete in club relays as well as his many other events. He travelled to Penguin as part of the Eastern Suburbs team competing in the Tasmanian Club Championships where he competed in the 4x100m relay, the 800m and the 3000m over the course of the 2 half day event. He was also in the team that competed in the Nation Club Champs, where he was asked to run a 400m event to make up numbers about 30seconds after he finished his 3000m even before he had a chance to sit down. Without any argument he turned around and went to the start of the 400m where he got about a minutes recovery before the race started. I was surprised to see how quickly he was running and finished with a time of 54.88 seconds not far off his PB. In addition to all of this he was also a member of the senior 4x400m team at state champs and helped out the club at the car parking fundraiser. Well done Aaron and keep up the good work.

Captains Report 2006/07

Throughout the year there were many amazing individual performances. At the state championships then ES men this year claimed 28 gold, 22 silver, and 22 bronze medals. A number of these medals were won from the relay teams, this was no doubt helped by the eagerness of so many athletes to run relays after interclub during the season so that we were no strangers to running with a batten. If it is possible, an even more impressive feat was the number of personal bests that were achieved throughout the year. All these achievements don't come easily and a lot of work needs to be done by the athletes and their coaches. A massive thankyou goes out to all the coaches that have helped out Eastern Suburbs athletes this year and especially the club coaches Peter Turnock, Wayne Mason, Kevin Alomes, Peter McDonald, Evan Peacock and Darren Alomes for their continued commitment to their athletes and the club, thankyou. Of course it is the athletes at the end of the day that need to do the training and run the races, so well done to everyone and thankyou for making it such an enjoyable year and I hope to see you all back again for the 2007/08 season.

TREASURER'S REPORT 2006-07

For the year ended 30 June 2007, the Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club recorded a net surplus of \$2 580.96. This is an excellent result, given that we achieved a deficit of \$681.94 in 2005-06.

For 2006-07, overall income was up by \$5 070.87 or 53.36%. Primarily, this was as a result of registration fees (\$3 421.00) being paid to the Club and an increase of \$839.50 to \$3 421.00 (\$2 581.50, 2005-06) in income received from Round the River sponsorship and entry fees.

Donations are received when club members, friends and athlete parents undertake volunteer work in order to raise funds for the Club. Activities undertaken during 2006-07 included the City to Casino and Point to Pinnacle fun runs, Parliament House car parking, and the Race to the Taste.

The Round the River Run was again financially successful for the Club, with sponsorship and entry fees exceeding costs by \$2 505.00 (2005-06, \$1 461.50). In this regard, the financial contribution made by Mike Pace of Pace Financial Services greatly assisted the Club in conducting this activity.

In the area of expenditure, the Club considers it important that it is able to provide travel subsidies to members who have gained state selection, and during 2006-07 paid \$1 195.00 in subsidies to club members.

Finally, I would like to thank all my fellow Committee members for their assistance, as well as the athletes and parents who have assisted in any way throughout the past year.
