## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

What a great year we have had!

The pandemic has impacted us all in many ways over the past year, however we put that behind us to have a successful cross country and track and field season.

While the number of registered athletes were down on prior years, it was great to see long standing members re-join the club after many years away from the sport. We had 70 'all year' registered athletes, 38 females and 32 males and 20 'out of stadium only' athletes. This season had 6 athletes compete in all 16 track and field rounds – 3 males and 3 females. Well done!

Congratulations to all our athletes who achieved personal bests, records, and the achievements at personal and competitive levels. This season 310 PB's were achieved across the season with Lacey Tilyard and Nathan Wass achieving the most PB's in a season! We were successful in winning the Greg Blake Shield and the F.E Kohl Shield Trophies.

It is fantastic to see athletes stepping up to coach and share their knowledge and love of the sport with our emerging juniors. A special mention to Rachel Hosie for being awarded the Emerging Coach of the Year at the Athletics Tasmania Awards Dinner.

Congratulations to Isabella Hippel, Luke Palmer and Arielle Cannell for taking out the respective Athletics Tasmania Athlete of the Year Awards.

I would like to recognise Kiani Allen for breaking a 30-year-old club record in the 100m. Kiani ran 11.87 to better Susan Andrews record of 11.90 set in 1991. Kiani is another great role model we have within the club for her commitment to training.

Volunteers and coaches are what make it possible for us to compete each week. I thank all the volunteers who assisted in various officiating positions – those who give up your own events or watching your children to volunteer. To our coaches, we are very fortunate to have great mentors. Regardless of ability or ambitions you are a huge part of supporting athletes to participate and enjoy our sport. On a sad note, we acknowledge the passing Danny Byas, a long-standing member and supporter of our club.

The 2021-22 committee has shown the commitment to our younger generation with continuing discussion on how we support and continue to invest in our athletes to grow as athletes and individuals. This season we financially supported a number of athletes and officials to travel interstate for competition. We also thank Ebony Webb for her time on the committee and wish her all the best as she takes a year away to continue study on an athletics scholarship to San Francisco University. I would like to acknowledge Maureen McDonald for recording our performances and PB's – It is not track season without freddo frogs for our PB's and Jarrod Gibson for continuing to provide his knowledge, passion and tireless work above and beyond for us – the athletes!

We look forward to seeing new and returning athletes join us for 2022-23 season. The coming year will hopefully see more opportunity for athletes to achieve records, personal bests and participate locally and interstate.

## **Treasurer's Report 2021-2022**

The Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club Inc (ESAC) recorded a small trading loss of \$453.45 for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022. ESAC is in a strong financial position with a working account of \$4,538.24 and a term deposit of \$37,000.00. The term deposit is due to mature on 19 August 2022. ESAC holds an inventory of clothing valued at \$3,167.00 and has assets valued at \$4,390.00 (branded shade tent, public address system and perpetual trophies).

Our main sources of income were memberships fees (\$1,794.50), donations (\$1,700.00) and fundraising (\$750.00). On behalf of the ESAC, I thank Roger Hosie of RSM Insurance for his support and sponsorship, as well as those who helped on the City to Casino and the SATIS XC. The latter was undertaken by life members Wayne Mason and Jarrod Gibson, for which ESAC received a significant donation. Previous fundraising events such as Round the River Run and Point to Pinnacle were not undertaken in 2021–2022. The decision by most Athletics South Clubs to include a club component as part of athlete registration contributed to limiting the associated income loss.

The main expenditures were uniforms and clothing (\$2,256.10), travel subsidies to assist our members to attend competitions on the Australian mainland (\$1,770.00), and costs associated with running and providing awards, trophies and running the AGM and trophy night (\$1,740.23).
