PRESIDENT'S REPORT

We had 70 registered athletes which remains unchanged on last year; 6 of those were new Track and Field registrations and 1 returned after a long break from the sport.

Congratulations to all our athletes who achieved personal bests, records, and achievements at personal and competitive levels. 315 PBs were achieved across the season with Nathan and Aaliyah Wass achieving the most PBs for the season! At the State Championships we were successful in winning the Greg Blake Shield and the F.E Kohl Shield Trophies. In local competition we had a successful season winning the Athletics South Female Premiership and Club Multi Event and runner up Combined and Men's Premiership. It is great to see the number of men competing increase.

We had a number of people receive awards at the various levels, with Arielle Cannell (U16, Throws), Jarrod Gibson (Official of the Year) and Roger Hosie (Coach of the Year) being acknowledged at the Athletics Tasmania level, while Athletics South acknowledged Arielle Cannell and Alejandro Fisher (U16), Isabella Hippel and Zarian Simcox (U20), Simon Calvert and Rachel Hosie (Open), Caitlin Stalker (Top Points Scorer) and Cheryl Wilson (Officials Recognition). Athletics Australia Service pins were also awarded to Jarrod Gibson (Gold, 30 years) and, tonight, Andrew Edwards (Silver, 20 years). Andrew was also awarded an Athletics Tasmania Merit Award, which we shall also present tonight.

Across the last Winter Season, we had a small but solid participation, which saw us finish 3rd in both the Men's and Women's Premiership, with a number of new athletes, of varying ages, joining and enjoying the social aspect as well as the competitive elements. We had 23 athletes represent Eastern Suburbs at the recent Australian Open and Junior Championships, this is a remarkable 33% of our members.

On a sad note, we acknowledge the passing of a number of people with links to the Club. This includes past committee member/coach Craig Griggs, long term cross country athlete Peter Clarke, former junior athlete Eric Cannell, former Official (and father/grandfather of past athletes) Philip Knott, and recently, former official/parent Jon Doole.

We recently recognised Jarrod Gibson at the ESAC Awards night, being awarded the Best Club Person. Volunteers and coaches are what make it possible for us to compete each week. I thank not only Jarrod but all our volunteers who assisted in various officiating positions – those who give up your own events or watching your children to volunteer. It is increasingly becoming difficult to find volunteers in varying capacities, I encourage you to step up and support our competitors. There are many willing and able to support you. I would also like to mention Lynne Welling for her ongoing commitment to welcoming and coaching a large amount of new and returning athletes twice a week, regardless of the conditions.

We have welcomed some new faces to the 2022-23 committee and our commitment to financially supporting our athletes continues. This season we financially supported 10 athletes and officials to travel interstate for competition.

We look forward to seeing new and returning athletes join us for 2023-24 season. The coming year will hopefully see more opportunity for athletes to achieve records, personal bests and participate locally and interstate.

Treasurer's Report 2022-2023

The Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club Inc (ESAC) recorded a trading profit of \$1,963.06 for the year ending 30th June 2023 – a turnaround of \$2,416.51 from the previous year. ESAC continues to be in a strong financial position with a working account of \$6,221.52 and a term deposit of \$37,556.18. The term deposit is due to mature on 19 October 2023. ESAC holds an inventory of clothing valued at \$2,890.60 and has assets valued at \$4,390.00 (two branded shade tents, a public address system and eight perpetual trophies).

Our main sources of income were memberships fees (\$1,810.00), donations (\$1,500.00) and fundraising (\$1,300.00). On behalf of the ESAC, I thank Roger Hosie of RSM Insurance for his support and sponsorship, as well as those who volunteered their time at the City to Casino, Hobart Marathon, Hobart Triathlon, and the SATIS Cross Country.

The main expenditures were uniforms and clothing (\$1,748.60), travel subsidies to assist our members to attend competitions on the Australian mainland (\$2,173.00), and costs associated with running the AGM and trophy night and providing awards and trophies (\$620.05).
