The structure of the Committee of ESAC and the procedures for nomination/election are contained in the ESAC Constitution.

Part 6 of that document states that the current elected positions of the Committee are as follows;

- iii) President
- iv) Vice president
- v) Secretary
- vi) Treasurer
- vii) Assistant Secretary/Treasurer
- ix) Committee members (maximum of 5)

It further states that completed nomination forms should be forwarded to the President(esac.tas@gmail.com) no later than 14 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting 24 July 2024 (that being 7pm 10 July 2024), signed by a nominator and seconder, both of whom shall be members, and annotated by the nominee accepting the nomination.

Details of who is eligible to nominate, second and be nominated, are deemed to be the same as those eligible to vote at the AGM and are defined by the Constitution and associated By laws as follows;



CONSTITUTION

9. VOTING

Voting rights at any General meeting shall be available to life members and financial competing members and associate members who have attained the age of 16 years on the date of the meeting, and are recorded as financial 14 days prior to the Meeting on the registration system used by Athletics Tasmania.

BY LAWS

5. VOTING

The following shall have voting rights at any Annual or Special General Meeting;

- a) Life members;
- b) Committee members;
- c) Any coach or official who is registered as a member of the Club through the registration system used by the state governing body at the time of the meeting (RevSport);
- d) Any athlete who is registered as an Out Of Stadium or All Year athlete with the Club through the registration system used by the state governing body at the time of the meeting; and
- e) In the case of any person who meets the above criteria but has not attained the age of 16 years at the time of the meeting, their parent or legal guardian.

No person shall have more than one vote, with the exception of the President if required as a deliberative vote.
