COMMITTEE REPORT

The current season has seen an increase in membership, with current registration numbers for 2023-24 being 133, with 66 All Competition, 56 Out of Stadium Only, 10 Officials/Volunteers and 1 Non-Resident. Our recruiting has seen a balance of younger athletes, as well as a pleasantly large number of adult athletes (including a large percentage of the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra, courtesy of a targeted recruitment drive by one of our members).

Numbers across the summer season were fairly consistent, without the normal post Christmas drop off. This helped to see us retain both the Athletics South Women's Premiership and the Athletics Tasmania Kohl Shield.

It was also pleasing to see a number of athletes and officials achieve selection at both Tasmanian and Australian level, culminating in Arielle Cannell, Xavier Leauma and Jarrod Gibson all being selected for the Oceania Athletics Championships in Suva, Fiji, with both Arielle and Xavier medalling in the Hammer Throw.

Across the current Winter Season, we have seen a marked increase in both participation and results, with the men currently sitting in second well into the second half of the season, while the girls sit in third, with a number of 2nd places from both genders. The women's competition particularly has been very close this year, and the other highlight has been the amount of people regularly competing in Club uniform.

We continue to struggle with fulfilling out officiating and volunteering commitments across the year, with an increasingly small number of people doing what should be evenly spread across our membership. Just because Hammer is our Club duty, it doesn't mean that only the families of Hammer throwers are responsible. This may change this year to another discipline, but regardless of what our duty is, it is the CLUB duty. There are a number of gates in the fence at the Domain, it isn't hard to put your hand up and walk through the fence on occasion

As you would have seen from the agenda, we have the bare minimum of nominations for the committee, again a very small number doing all the work. We acknowledge the service of Kimberley Geelan and Michelle Cockerell who are both stepping down from the Committee this year, and also note that 3 long serving committee members have indicated that this may be their last year, we really need some people to step up, either tonight, or over the next few weeks. It is not a huge commitment, and even less if it is spread across a wider base.

We look forward to seeing new and returning athletes join us for 2024-25 season. There are a number of initiatives coming up this summer season, which should allow lots of opportunities for you to perform at participate at whichever level you choose to target, whether this be State/National representation, or a PB or just 1 more point than last week.

Treasurer's Report 2023-2024

The Eastern Suburbs Athletic Club Inc (ESAC) recorded a trading profit of \$553.46 for the year ending 30th June 2024. ESAC continues to be in a strong financial position with a trading account of \$7,311.99 and a term deposit of \$37,556.18. ESAC holds an inventory of clothing valued at \$2,353.60 and has assets valued at \$4,390.00 (two branded shade tents, a public address system and eight perpetual trophies).

Our main sources of income were fundraising (\$2,891.80), memberships fees (\$1,900.00) and a donation from RSM Insurance (\$1,500.00). On behalf of the ESAC, I thank Roger Hosie of RSM Insurance for his support and sponsorship, as well as those who volunteered their time at the City to Casino, Hobart Marathon, Hobart Triathlon, and the SATIS Cross Country.

I am pleased to report that our main expenditure (\$5,527.00) was supporting athletes and officials with travel subsidies to attend competitions on the Australian mainland and the Oceania Athletics in Fiji. The other significant expenditure was the cost associated with running the AGM and trophy night and providing awards and trophies (\$1,179.92).
